## Workshop Description

With more and more health professionals providing blood pressure (BP) screening, it is imperative that the proper measurement techniques and standards are being applied. This workshop will update attendees on the current recommended BP measurement technique and its rationale, as well as provide tips and pitfalls in getting an accurate reading. The following are some facts to consider:

- Blood pressure measurement standards change periodically
- Measurement techniques and recordings should be accurate and standardized so readings taken by different persons will be both comparable and reliable.
- Cardiovascular risk and long-term treatment implications hinge on precise readings.



## Course Objectives

1. Recognize the importance of a Blood Pressure Screening in the congregational/community setting.
2. Review the steps of accurate blood pressure measurement
3. Demonstrate the use of documentation materials used during a congregational/community blood pressure screening.
4. Practice techniques of accurate blood pressure measurement.
